**ILL** – Individual Lighting Lane, top ride(s) at each park gains you access to lightning lane for a set fee per person.

- Can purchase with or without Genie.
- These are the most popular rides at each park.
- Disney resort guests can book at 7 am, all others can book at the park open.
- Magic Kingdom: Tron and Seven Dwarfs Mine Train
- Epcot: Guardians of the Galaxy Cosmic Rewind
- Hollywood Studios: Star Wars Rise of the Resistance
- Animal Kingdom: Avatar Flight of Passage

**VQ** – Virtual Queue, newest rides at Disney World. Virtual Queue is free, you will still wait in a line (45-60 minutes), but it gets you on the newest and most popular rides without an additional fee.

- Magic Kingdom: Tron
- Epcot: Guardians of the Galaxy Cosmic Rewind

**MDE** – My Disney Experience – App on your phone where you access Genie, Genie +, book lightning lanes, mobile order food, find attraction wait times and more

**Genie** – Free service that helps plan your day.

**Genie +** - set fee per day per park, allows you to book 2-3 rides (or more) utilizing the lightning lane. Includes photo pass photos for ride pictures. Current ride photos:

- Magic Kingdom: Tron, Seven Dwarves, Pirates, Space Mountain, Buzz Lightyear
- Epcot: Frozen, Guardians
- Animal Kingdom: Everest, Dinosaur
- Hollywood Studios: Slinky, Tower, Rock N' Roller Coaster

**Rope Drop** – Park Open, it's called Rope Drop as they used to drop a rope to open the park.

- Disney Resort Guest: 30 minutes before the park opens.
- Non-Disney Resort Guests: Park Open
- Magic Kingdom ONLY: Main Street opens 1 hour before early entry; shops are open on Main Street.
  - Disney Resort Guests can access the lands on the right: Tomorrowland and Fantasy Land
  - o Non-Disney Resort Guests: Recommend rope-dropping Adventureland.
  - o Adventureland, Frontierland, Liberty Square

**Memory Maker** – Disney's paid photo service in the parks. Numerous locations throughout each park with professional Disney photographers. Locations are generally with great backdrops and park icons. Some locations also have "magic shots" which add something special into your photos (character, fireworks, etc)

**Minnie Van** – Ride Service offer exclusively through the Lyft app, drivers are Disney employees. At Magic Kingdom only ride service that can drop/pick-up at Bus Loop near park entry. All other services drop you off at the Transportation and Ticket Center (TTC)

**TTC** – Transportation and Ticket Center; main parking lot for Magic Kingdom. Take a ferry boat or Monorail from TTC to Magic Kingdom Park.

**Skyliner** – Disney transportation service, utilizing gondolas to move you quickly from one location to the next. Skyliner runs from Art of Animation, Pop Century, Riviera and Caribbean Beach to Hollywood Studios and Epcot (International Gateway)

**Monorail** – Disney transportation service, Express runs from the TTC to the front gates of Magic Kingdom. Also at the TTC is a monorail that runs to EPCOT and bake to the TTC. Resort Monorail loop includes stops at Magic Kingdom, Contemporary Resort, Grand Floridian Resort and Polynesian Village Resort.

MK – Magic Kingdom Park

**AK** – Animal Kingdom Park

**HS** – Hollywood Studios

AP - Annual Passholder

**ADR** – Advanced Dining Reservation, Disney resort guests can make reservations 60 days prior plus 10 days. Non-resort guests can make dining reservations 60 days prior only.

- Online dining reservations open at 6am EST each day, sometimes they drop early recommend to start looking at 5:40am EST, they tend to open up reservations a bit earlier than 6am EST each day.
- **Resort Guests Example**: Disney resort May 6<sup>th</sup> to 13<sup>th</sup>, can make dining reservations on March 7<sup>th</sup>, for any day during their stay (up to 10 days from check-in).
  - On March 7<sup>th</sup> can book a dining reservation(s) for May 6<sup>th</sup> to 13<sup>th</sup>.
  - May be easier to find the hard-to-get reservations by booking them further out than the
    60 days, for example on March 7<sup>th</sup> try and book Cinderella's Table for May 11<sup>th</sup>.
- **Non-Resort Guests Example**: Staying May 6<sup>th</sup> to 13<sup>th</sup> at NON-Disney resort/hotel, can make dining reservations on:
  - o March 7<sup>th</sup> for May 6<sup>th</sup>
  - o March 8th for May 7th
  - o March 9th for May 8th
  - And so on

**DVC** – Disney Vacation Club, Disney's timeshare option. Some resort options are DVC only, regular guests can book these rooms at times, but for an increased cost
